

East Elementary MCA Test Scores 2011

East Elementary once again had very strong MCA test scores in reading and math for the 2010-2011 school year. At East Elementary all eight of the specific student targeted groups measured under The No Child Left Behind Law met the math and reading proficiency targets. The test scores below are only for Maple River East and are compared to the Minnesota State Average test score. Overall the entire district saw very strong test scores. The proficiency percentages listed below refer to the percent of students in a class or group that made the target score set by the State of Minnesota. This was the first year that elementary students took the Math MCA (III) on-line. That, along with a much high rigor on the new test, drove down state test scores during this initial year.
